



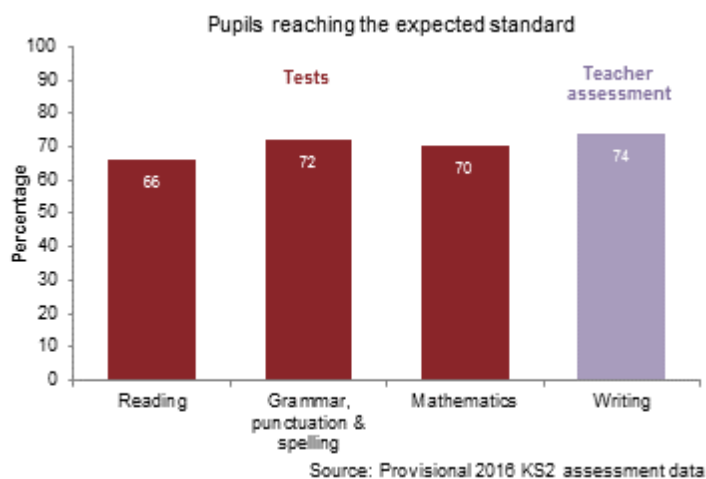
Data Results 2015-16

This year's data for KS1 & KS2 cannot be compared to that of previous years as tests were based on end of year age expectation and no longer refer to levels as in previous years.

KS2 Data

Nationally 53% of KS2 children achieved the desired age related expectation at the end of Year 6, in Reading, Writing and Maths. In **East Hanningfield 72%** of year 6 pupils achieved the desired expectation. The national floor target this year is 65% therefore we are above this.

National percentages for each subject.



Our Year 6 children (18 pupils) achieving the expected standard in;

Reading - 77.8% **above national**

Grammar, punctuation & spelling - 77.8% **above national**

Mathematics - 77.8% **above national**

Writing - 88.9% with 16.7% achieving greater depth **above national**

KS1 Data

Data at this point cannot be compared with national; we await Raiseonline for this comparison to be made.

The percentage of Year 2 children achieving end of year age expectations are as follows;

Reading - 81.8% at age related expectation or greater

Writing - 72.7% at age related expectation or greater

Maths - 90.9% at age related expectation or greater

Once Raiseonline has been published the comparison data will be shown.

Year 1 Phonics Test

85.7% of our Year 1 children passed the phonics check. Nationally last year (15-16), 77% of children passed the phonics check.

Reception - Good level of Development

72.7 % of children (11 pupils) reached a good level of development at the end of the academic year.
