Impact on Learning

All pupil premium children were able to attend the residential trip developing their social skills and increasing confidence/achievements.

Due to the level of LSA support provided we can ensure that children are able to access a range of intervention groups to support learning and close the gap. These include; Attack, Toe by Toe, Springboard, time to talk. Individual children's progress can be seen and means they are able to meet end of year expectations.

Precision grids have been set and individual needs are effectively covered, supporting the planning of the classteacher. These can include speech and language support, gym trail and individual reading programs.

Wellbeing takes place weekly and allows children to develop their social and emotional skills. It enables children who may not be ready to learn to have an opportunity to discuss worries and help with strategies to cope with situations as they arise.
