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<p>Impact on Learning</p>
<p>17-18</p> <p>Due to the small number of children receiving pupil premium, percentages have to be considered. Pupil premium allowed all children that have extracurricular needs whether that be children with SEN or those who are most able to be supported in targeted groups as detailed above. At the end of KS 1 100% of PP children achieved the expected standards. At the end of key stage 2 66.6% achieved the expected standard in reading, writing and maths. 33.3% pupils achieved the higher standard.</p>
